## Features and Benefits of CUCKOO Electric Water Purifier

### Product Benefits

- **Nano Positive Filtering System**  
Application of CUCKOO Electric Water Purifier's Nano Positive Filtering System produces clean and healthy water containing minerals.
- **Healthy electric water purifier**  
You may drink water, which has passed a filter in an instantaneous cooling, heating or purification method, as cold, hot or room temperature water.
- **Water purifier featuring an ultraslim design and Multiple functions**  
Cold water, hot water, room temperature water and Sterilization(Cleaning) Water are available in a single water purifier and, thanks to its slim and classy design, spaces can be used in a more efficient manner.
- **Electrolytic Sterilization(Cleaning) System**  
An Electrolytic Sterilization(Cleaning) System is applied to enable sanitary use of the water purifier, and Sterilization(Cleaning) Water is dispensed as the sink faucet to utilize it to clean food ingredients and kitchenware.
- **Economical and Eco-Friendly Water Filtration System**  
An extremely economical and eco-friendly water purification system, which produces no wasted water in the process of water filtration through a Nano Positive Filter, has been selected.
- **Button Lock/Functional Lock**  
To prevent potential accidents as a result of product misuse by children or the elderly, Button Lock and Functional Lock (hot water, Sterilization(Cleaning) Water) have been added.
- **Water Leak Prevention System**  
Water leakage that may be caused during product usage is detected and prevented to enable safe use of the water purifier.
- **Non-stop Dispensing Function**  
You can continuously dispense cold water, hot water, and room temperature water.
- **Fixed Quantity Dispensing Function**  
It is convenient to be able to dispense a fixed quantity, either One Cup (about 250cc) or Half Cup (about 120cc), of cold water, hot water or room temperature water.

### About Power

Make sure to use it on an outlet exclusively for 220V -240V and the current rating of 13A or greater that can be grounded, and do not insert power plugs of several products in a single outlet at the same time.



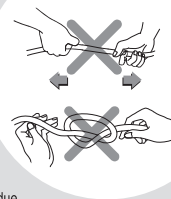
- If you use it with a lot of products, this may cause a fire or an electric shock. Please check the power outlet regularly.
- If it is not properly grounded, this may cause electric shock due to a short circuit.
- If there is a foreign substance or moisture on the Power Plug, wipe it thoroughly before use.

Do not install where it may be exposed to moisture, excessive dust, and splashing water.

- Install the product in a clean environment.
- This may cause a malfunction, electric shock or fire.



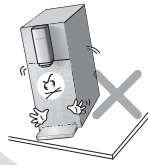
Do not install the product in a place from which gas may be leaked or where an air conditioner or a heater is located.



- There is a risk of explosion or fire.

Do not install the product near the bathroom.

Do not install the product on an uneven surface or a slope, or on a pad, cushion, blanket or carpet.



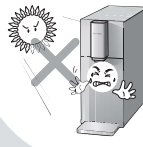

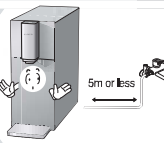

Make sure that the length of the Tap Water Supply Tube doesn't exceed 5 m from the Tap Water Supply Valve.

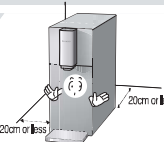


- If you do not do so, it may cause poor performance of the product.

Do not lift the drain hose, which is connected to the product, over the surface where the product is installed, and do not connect it to the water purifier over a distance of 3m or greater.

- The drainage function may not work smoothly.

Secure at least 20cm from walls and install the product on a solid and flat surface.



- If you do not do so, it may cause poor performance of the product.

When connecting the drain hose to the drain while letting the hose touch the floor of the kitchen, etc., do not lift it 30cm or higher from the floor.

- The drainage function may not work smoothly.

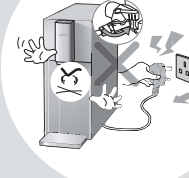
If water leaks from the inside of a product or forms a puddle in the surroundings, close the Tap Water Supply Valve, turn off the Power button, pull out the power plug and contact our Customer Service Center.

- There is a risk of electric shock.



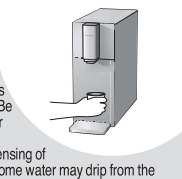
If you smell burning or see smoke arising from the product, unplug it immediately and close the Tap Water Supply Valve. After that, please contact our Customer Service Center.

- This may cause a fire.



Be careful when using high-temperature water or hot water.

- Hot water (high-temperature water) may be splashed so make sure it does not come into contact with the body. (Be careful, especially, when the elderly or children use the product.)
- After stopping or terminating the dispensing of hot water (high-temperature water), some water may drip from the inside of the outlet so take out the cup after confirming it.



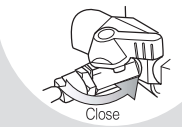
The product should be installed and removed by our service technicians through the Customer Service Center.

Pay attention to children or anyone not to control the Control Panel too often.

- This may cause damage to the product and/or a safety-related accident.

When replacing the filter, close the Tap Water Supply Valve (adapter). (The Tap Water Supply Valve is typically located below the sink or at the faucet.)

- This may cause a water leak.



Prevent an air intake hole, air discharge hole, and gaps from being blocked or having foreign substances stuck inside such as a needle, cleaning pin, and metals.

- If you do not do so, this may cause an electric shock or fire.

Scrubbing the External Valve with a brush or a dishwashing sponge may damage the plating and, also, cause minerals to become stuck on it.

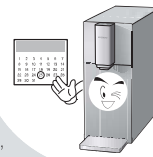
Make sure the Cooling Water Tank Cover inside the product and the Top Cover are completely closed before use.

- It's also to keep foreign material away.



Replace the filters according to the replacement cycle.

- If you do not do so, This may cause poor filter performance or bad odor.
- Regarding the filter replacement cycle, refer to Page 31.



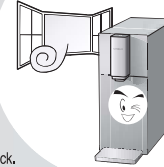
If the product has not been used for a long period of time, perform the Immediate Auto Sterilization(Cleaning) function once before use.

- Use the Immediate Sterilization(Cleaning) function to be able to easily clean the pipes and refrigerant tank (refer to Page 21).



When gas or propane leaks, do not pull out the Power Cord of the product but immediately open the windows to ventilate.

- This may cause a fire or electric shock.



Do not use water from the purifier for a fishbowl or fish tank.

- The room temperature water may not be suitable for breeding fish. Depending on the circumstances, fish may die.

If you have not used the Sink Faucet for more than a day, it can be polluted. When reusing the sink faucet, let the water flow for about 1 to 2 minutes before use.

Must not use NON-Cuckoo Water Purifier filters.

- Use of a non-genuine filter other than a genuine CUCKOO filter may deteriorate the water purification performance, strange taste of the water, leakage and/or damage to the product.

Do not lean the product at a 30-degree angle or more when moving the product.

- This may cause poor performance of the product.

Do not randomly connect an apparatus to reduce pressure to the Hot Water Apparatus Pipe.

Please take caution when using steam Sterilization(Cleaning).



- During steam Sterilization(Cleaning), make sure that steam does not reach the body. (Extra caution is required for the elderly and children.)
- During steam Sterilization(Cleaning), do not grab or remove the Sterilization(Cleaning) cup. (Regarding how to cancel Sterilization(Cleaning), refer to page 21)

## During Use

This product is exclusively for AC 220V-240V only, and make sure to use an outlet exclusively for 220V-240V that can be grounded.

When you use an extension cord (such as a multi-power outlet), do not simultaneously connect any other product.

Failure to ground may cause electric shock due to a short circuit.

Be sure to only use the product after grounding.

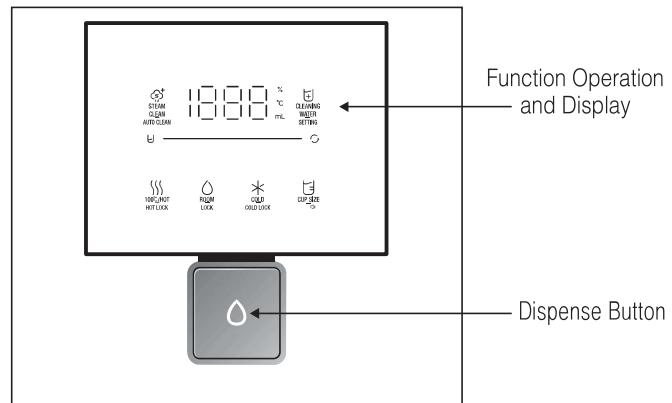
- 1 In the case of an outlet with a grounding terminal  
When there is a grounding terminal, you can immediately use the power outlet without any extra work.
- 2 In the case of an outlet without a grounding terminal  
Check if the earth leakage breaker is installed and, if it is not installed, install one and then use the product. If there is no earth leakage breaker, it may cause a fire.



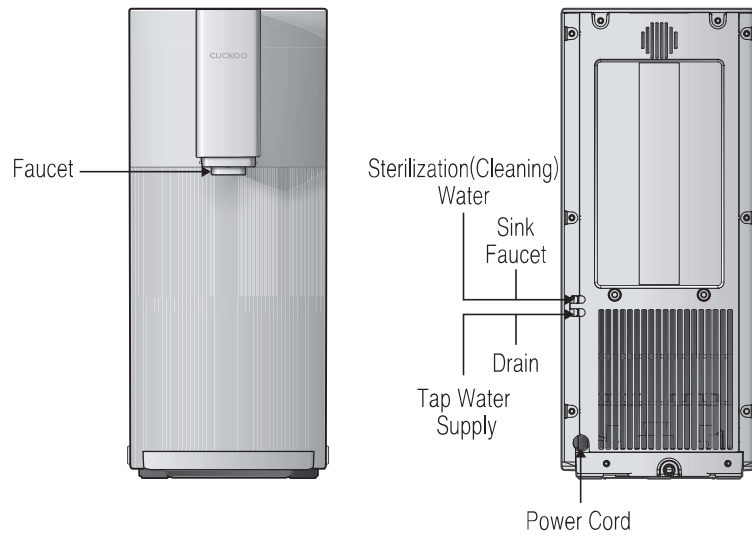

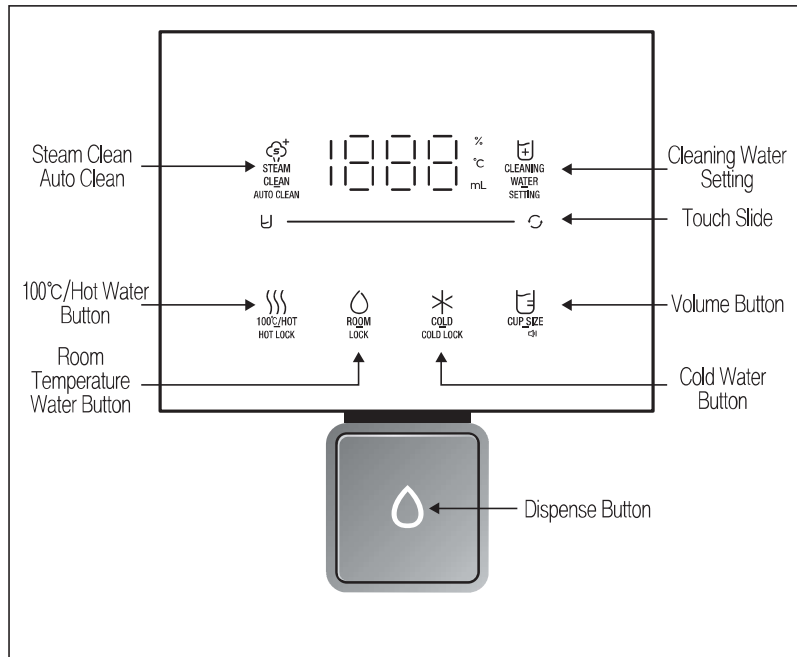

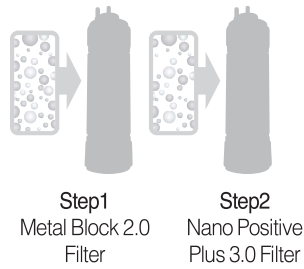

Level 1	Metal Block 2.0 Filter	Absorbs and removes seven heavy metals (mercury, lead, cadmium, arsenic, iron, aluminum, copper), organic chemicals, etc.

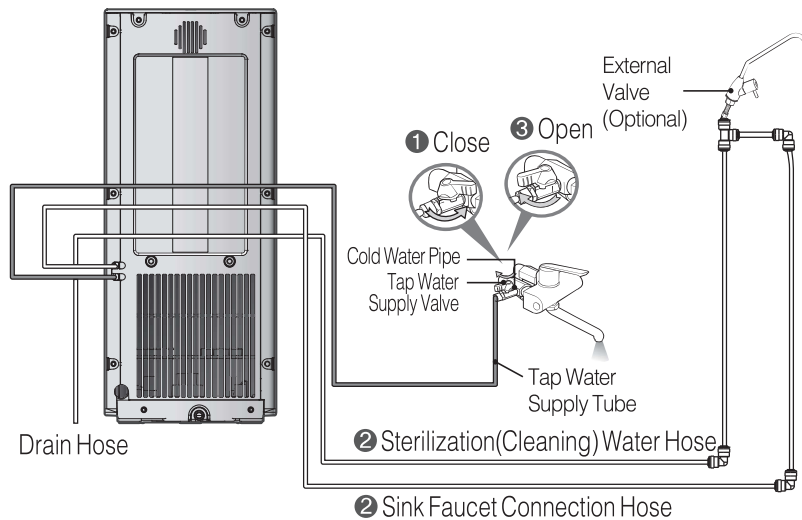

## How to Install the Product



### How to Install the Product

**1** Install the Tap Water Supply Valve and turn it to CLOSE.

- Please make sure that you use tap water from the water supply. Do not use other water sources, such as groundwater.

**2** Connect the Tap Water Supply Hose to the inlet and the Drain Hose to the drain.

- (When installing the sink faucet) Connect the sink faucet connection hose, sink faucet dispensing hose and Sterilization (Cleaning) water hose to the sink faucet connection area.
- Fix the Drain Hose so that water discharged from the hose does not splash to the surroundings.
- Do not place the Drain Hose above the installation surface or connect it to the water purifier over a distance of 3m or greater.
- When connecting the drain hose to the drain while letting the hose touch the floor of the kitchen, etc., do not lift it 30cm or higher from the floor.

**3** Turn the Tap Water Supply Valve to OPEN. **4** Connect the power.

**5** Use the Auto Filter Cleaning function to clean the filter (regarding the Auto Filter Cleaning, refer to Page 24).

After the installation has completed, please check if water leaks from the tube connecting parts.

- Tap Water Supply Valve (Tube)
- Tap Water (Inlet) Hose, Sink Faucet Connection Hose, Drain Hose
- Sink Faucet Dispensing Hose, Sterilization (Cleaning) Water Hose
- Filter Connection Tube

※ In order to guarantee the optimum performance of the product, consult with the technician of our company about the detailed method of installation.

※ The water used for inspection process during production of the product may remain inside the product. Do not worry as it is not a used product.

※ When installing the product, do not reuse the Tap Water Supply Valve and the tubes that were used before.

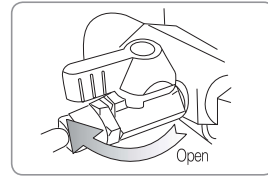

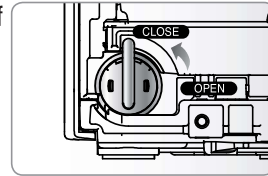
**1** Open the Tap Water Supply Valve.

- ▶ Open the Tap Water Supply Valve, and check if there is water leak on each connection part.
- Tap Water Supply Valves and water (inlet) and drain of the product



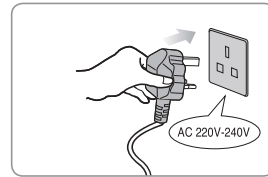
**2** Turn the Close lever of the filter door on the right side of the product to the CLOSE direction.

- Water is supplied to the water purifier.

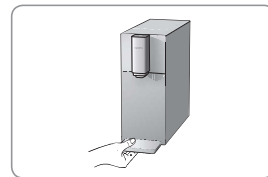


**3** Connect the power.

- ▶ This product is exclusively for 220V-240V .  
Please make sure to plug it into a proper outlet.

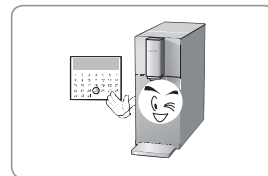


**4** Empty out the tray on a regular basis.



**5** Exchange and manage the filter on a regular basis.

- ▶ Please clean and replace the filters regularly so that you can always enjoy pure and clean water.
- ▶ Regarding the filter replacement cycle, refer to Page 31.



## How To Use



### To Set Functions

#### ① Standby Mode

- ▶ It is the mode in which it waits for cold water, hot water, room temperature water or Sterilization (Cleaning) water to be dispensed. The display panel turns on according to the selected feature and displays the dispensing volume.
- ▶ If the product is idle for 15 seconds, the display panel automatically turns off.
- ▶ If the product detects human presence while the display panel is off, the screen will automatically turn on. (Regarding the use of Hidden Display, refer to page 22)

#### ② User Setting Mode

- ▶ To get into this mode, press the [Cleaning Water/Settings] button for about 3 seconds in the Standby mode.

#### ③ Dispense Fixed Volume

- ▶ Press the [Dispense] button once to dispense a fixed volume of water.
- ▶ Use the [Cup Size] button to select the desired fixed volume.  
(120 ml → 250 ml → 1500 ml → 120 ml)
- ▶ Use the [Touch Slide] button to select the desired fixed volume.  
(Regarding the use of Touch Slide, refer to page 19)

### How to Set Cold Water Function

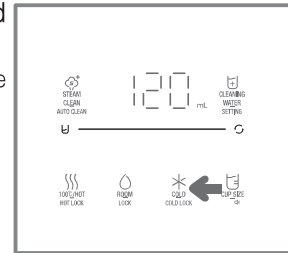
- 1 If the Cold Water Function is turned off, press the [Cold Water] button for 3 seconds to turn the function on.

- ▶ While the [Cold Water] button is being pressed, the Voice Guide will say: "Selecting Cold Water Function."
- ▶ Once the Cold Water Function is turned on, "ON" is displayed and the Voice Guide will say "Cold Water Function selected."

- 2 If you no longer wish to use cold water while the function is turned on, press the [Cold Water] button for 3 seconds to turn the function off.

- ▶ While the [Cold Water] button is being pressed, the Voice Guide will say "Canceling Cold Water Function."
- ▶ Once the Cold Water Function is turned off, "OFF" is displayed and the Voice Guide will say "Cold Water Function canceled."
- ▶ When the [Cold Water] button is pressed while the function is turned off, the Voice Guide will say "Cold Water Function off. Please turn on cold water function before use."

- ※ It is possible to dispense cold water in a stable manner about 1 hour after the Cold Water Function is turned on.
- ※ The function is initially set to be ON on the product.



### How To Dispense Cold Water

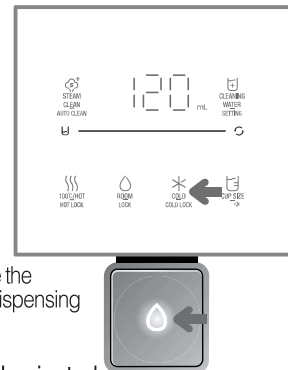
- 1 Press the [Cold Water] button and select Cold Water

- ▶ The Voice Guide will say "Cold Water."

- 2 How to Dispense Fixed Quantity

- ▶ Press the [Cup Size] button to select the desired dispensing quantity.
- ▶ Press the [Dispense] button once. Cold water will be dispensed
- ▶ When the selected quantity of water is dispensed, the water dispensing will end.
- ▶ If you press the [Dispense] button or any other button while the product is dispensing a fixed quantity of water, the water dispensing will end.

- 3 When dispensing cold water, the dispensing outlet is illuminated.  
(When the Mood function is turned OFF, the lamp will not be turned ON.)

### How To Use Room Temperature Water

- 1 Press the [Room Temperature Water] button to select room temperature water.
  - ▶ The Voice Guide will say "Room Temperature Water."

- 2 How to Dispense Fixed Quantity

- ▶ Press the [Cup Size] button to select the desired dispensing quantity.
- ▶ Press the [Dispense] button once.  
The room Temperature Water will be dispensed
- ▶ When the selected quantity of water is dispensed, the water dispensing will end.
- ▶ If you press the [Dispense] button or any other button while the product is dispensing a fixed quantity of water, the water dispensing will end.



- 3 When dispensing room temperature water, the dispensing outlet is illuminated.  
(When the Mood function is turned OFF, the Lamp will not be turned ON.)

### How to Set Child Lock

This is the function that prevents random control by children, etc. and protects them against burns. Once the function is set, the [Hot Water] button will not work.

- 1 Press the [Hot Water] button for about 3 seconds in Standby Mode to set the Child Lock.

- ▶ If the [Hot Water] button is pressed in the Child Lock state, "Loc\_" is displayed and the Voice Guide will say "Child lock on".
- ▶ If the [Hot Water] button is pressed for about 3 seconds during the Child Lock, "Un\_Loc\_" is displayed and the Child Lock will be canceled.

## How To Use

### How to Use Hot Water (typical hot water temperature of 100°C)

- 1 Press the [Hot Water] button and select Hot Water.
  - ▶ The Voice Guide will say "Hot Water."
- 2 How to Dispense Fixed Quantity
  - ▶ Press the [Cup Size] button to select the desired dispensing quantity.
  - ▶ Press the [Dispense] button once. After preheating, the hot water will be dispensed.
  - ▶ When the selected quantity of water is dispensed, the water dispensing will end.
  - ▶ If you press the [Dispense] button or any other button while the product is dispensing the fixed quantity of water, the water dispensing will end.
- 3 When dispensing hot water, the dispensing outlet is illuminated.  
(When the Mood function is turned OFF, the lamp will not be turned ON.)
  - ※ There is a risk of burns due to spattering of water. Thus, please put the cup near the faucet.
  - ▶ Press the [Dispense] button. Hot water will be dispensed.
  - ▶ If you keep pressing the [Dispense] button for two seconds or longer, the product will be changed to the Manual Dispensing status.
  - ▶ The Voice Guide will say "Water dispensing during pressing".
  - ▶ If you stop pressing the [Dispense] button during the Manual Dispensing, the water dispensing will end.
- 4 The temperature may differ depending on the surroundings and service conditions.



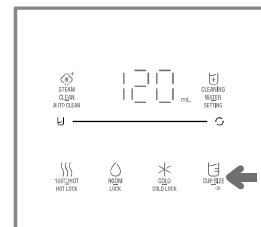
### How to Use Hot Water Temperature Function (Custom Hot Water)

- 1 How to Use the Hot Water Temperature Feature
  - ▶ Every time the [Hot Water] button is pressed, the temperature changes. The [Hot Water] button is illuminated in different colors with every change.
  - ▶ Select the [Hot Temp.] and press the [Dispense] button to dispense hot water at the selected temperature.
  - ▶ If you press the [Dispense] button or any other button while the product is dispensing hot water, the water dispensing will end.



### How to Dispense the Fixed Volume of Water

- 1 Every time the [Volume] button is pressed, the fixed volume changes.
  - ▶ 120 ml → 250 ml → 1500 ml → 120 ml
- 2 After selecting the desired fixed volume, press the [Dispense] button to dispense water at the selected volume.

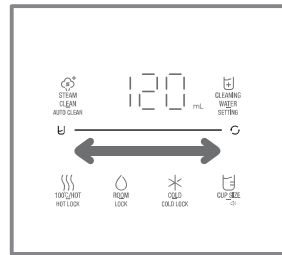

### How to Change the Dispensing Volume Using the Touch Slide

- ① Drag the Touch Slide area (marked with the arrow) in the center to change the dispensing volume.
- ② After selecting the desired volume, press the [Dispense] button to dispense water at the selected volume.
  - ▶ Using Touch Slide, the dispensing volume changes in 9 steps.



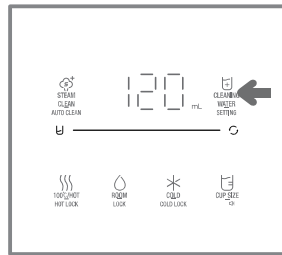

- ▶ After Sterilization(Cleaning), wash with clean water for over 3 times so that the Sterilization(Cleaning) water is completely removed.

※ Sterilization(Cleaning) water is not for drinking. Prevent anyone from drinking the Sterilization(Cleaning) water. (CUCKOO Sterilization(Cleaning) water is being managed within the standard scope of the "Drinking Water Management Act" so do not worry about using it but try to avoid drinking it.)

※ The sink faucet lever can be controlled to increase the concentration of the Sterilization(Cleaning) water.

    - ▶ Once the Immediate Auto Sterilization(Cleaning) begins, the Voice Guide will say "Start flow path Sterilization(Cleaning)."
    - ▶ The [Steam/Auto Clean] button display lamp is turned on and the progress of Sterilization(Cleaning) is displayed.
      - The progress is shown on the display panel in %.
  - 2 To cancel the Sterilization(Cleaning) operation, press the [Steam/Auto Clean] button during an Auto Sterilization(Cleaning) operation.
    - ▶ The Voice Guide will say "Flow path Sterilization canceled.", and the Sterilization(Cleaning) cancellation operation proceeds
    - ▶ Depending on the situation, it proceeds to follow-up processes such as Sterilization(Cleaning) water drainage, rinsing and input, and a certain period of time is taken until it reaches the Standby Mode in which intake is possible.



※ While auto Sterilization(Cleaning) is in progress, do not dispense water through the sink faucet.

### How to Use Immediate Faucet Sterilization(Cleaning) and Steam Sterilization(Cleaning)

- 1 Place the **Sterilization(Cleaning) cup**.
  - ▶ Before placing the cup, put the faucet unit back in place. When the faucet and Sterilization(Cleaning) cup are not in place, the Sterilization(Cleaning) cup may not be detected.
- 2 In the Standby mode, press the [Steam/Auto Clean] button to select.
  - ▶ When pressing the [Steam/Auto Clean] button once  
- Electrolysis faucet Sterilization(Cleaning) starts, and the Voice Guide will say, "Start faucet Sterilization."

  - ▶ When canceling Faucet Sterilization(Cleaning), water is dispensed to the faucet to clean the area so do not remove the cup.
    - ※ Please remove the Sterilization(Cleaning) cup after the operation is completed.



※ Sterilization(Cleaning) water is not for drinking. Prevent anyone from drinking the Sterilization(Cleaning) water.  
※ You may use steam Sterilization(Cleaning) once a day.  
※ Be careful of burns, as steam Sterilization(Cleaning) can be hot.  
※ Water droplets may form on the front of the product after steam Sterilization(Cleaning).  
※ Put the rubber packing of the Sterilization(Cleaning) cup to wrap the faucet without being pressed. Or the Sterilization(Cleaning) cup may not be detected.



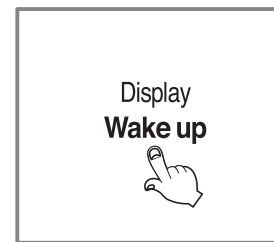

### How to Use the Hidden Display Feature

This feature is used to save power with the display panel turned off and the brightness of the display lamps reduced.

#### ① How to enter the Hidden Display mode

- ▶ After 15 seconds of no button input and no detection of human presence in the Standby mode

- ▶ Pull the pre-filter on the bottom surface of the product to detach it before washing it with water, drying and re-assembling it.

- If it is not cleaned for a long time, the cool water performance may be lowered.



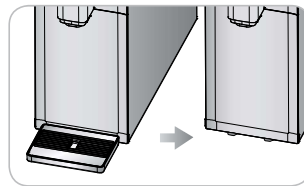

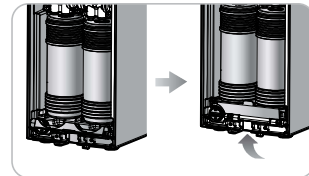

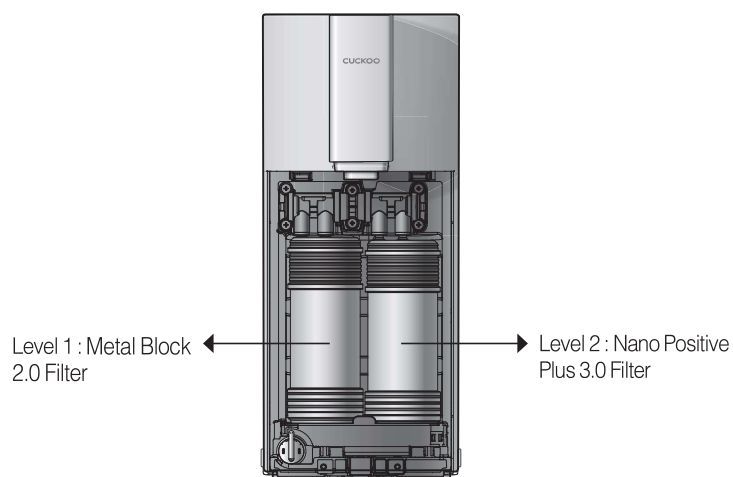
### Recommendations

- ▶ Filter Replacement Cycle

· Filter replacement cycle refers to a period during which a filter is expected to demonstrate its inherent performance as a result of a thorough review of the filter.

This is based on tap water where the inflow water and daily usage amount is about 10L (drinking water for 4 persons) so, if the amount of usage is greater than this, the replacement cycle may become shortened.
